☉ **Childcare for Adult Classes. (\$2)**

Adult students requiring Care during their study/course session. Childcare is automatically offered to Class care in priority to Occasional care spaces. Care available for ALL day courses.

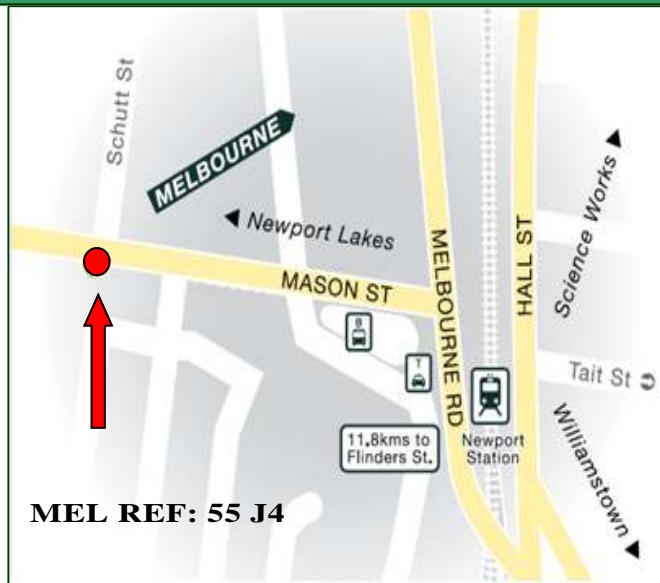
Clothing:
